The volunteer photographer is tasked with documenting the activities of the Emerado Volunteer Fire Department, including incident responses, training, community events, and other functions authorized by the fire chief or designee. Teamwork, attendance, attention, attitude, and aptitude are the basis of the framework for the volunteer photographer position.

Essential Functions of the Volunteer Photographer

- Respond to emergency calls for service in a non-firefighting or rescue operation capacity, department meetings and training, as well as community events, to document activities.
- Store photos on department owned computer. Nothing will be deleted without the approval of the fire chief or designee, as they may be of evidentiary value.
- Images captured at EVFD incidents or events are the property of the EVFD. This includes flash cards, thumb drives, and external hard drives provided by EVFD.
- The volunteer will be issued appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE), attire, and credentials identifying the volunteer as an Emerado Fire Department photographer, which must be worn at all times while in the field.
- Will be supplied with a camera, still or digital, and a bag or case. Photographer may use their own equipment with the understanding the department assumes no responsibility for damage, theft, or loss.
- Performs other related tasks as assigned by the fire chief or designee.

Skills and Qualifications

- Knowledge and skills with photography and possibly video equipment preferred.
- Knowledge and skills with computers.
- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- High School Diploma or GED Certificate
- Must have a valid driver's license.
- Must live within 20 minutes of the Emerado Fire Department
- Must pass a background check
